Applicant hereby requests permission from the Morgan County Commissioners to (bore under), or (span over), (construction within) County Road, located in Township of, Section No, Morgan County, Ohio.
Location of proposed crossing being generally described as follows:  Attach a map showing beginning point and termination point.  Said underground crossing to be forinch diameter line (gas, oil, water, etc Said aerial crossing to be for line (electric, telephone, TV cable, etc)  Said construction to be for poles, facilities, etc.
The applicant agrees to protect said <b>underground</b> line with ainch diameter casing and to place said line and casing a minimum of three (3) feet below the bottom of the ditch, to install said line and casing by auger method or push under as the County Engineer may direct, burying along side of highway with minor exceptions, the proposed line being placed within the confines of public right-of-way at a minimum depth of 36 inches and to leave the surface to the satisfaction of the Morgan County Engineer.
The applicant agrees to protect said <b>aeria</b> l line with a minimum ground clearance of feet (18 feet is minimum) over the highest point on the roadway surface. All structures being placed within the Count R/W must maintain a minimum horizontal offset of 8 feet for traffic safety. (Variance requests may be considered in special cases). And to leave the surface to the satisfaction of the Morgan County Engineer.
The construction of this project will begin on or about and will be completed by A notification will be made to the County Engineer at a minimum of two (2) working days before commencing the actual installation.
Applicant assumes all liability for any damages or accidents, property damage or bodily injury resulting from said installation.
The Board of Morgan County Commissioners by signing this giving permission to place the lines and cables within the confines of the County Highway Road System, are only for the express purpose of protecting the County Highway System.
Further, no lines shall go over or through structures as culverts, bridges, etc.
By granting permission, The Board does not purport to grant permission on behalf of any other person or entity having an interest in the land that may be affected and the duty of obtaining all other necessary permissions from the owner of any other interest in the land remains on the person, corporation, or company submitting this application.
The County shall not be liable for any damage done to any cables or lines in the ordinary maintenance of its roads. The applicant is to pay for a county inspector on the job as required by the County Engineer.
